DEAR FRIENDS OF THE CARLISLE FAMILY YMCA:

Together, we accomplished so much—here are some highlights from our inspiring 2024–25 fiscal year.

As we reflect on another remarkable year, we're filled with gratitude for the unwavering support of our members, donors, volunteers and staff. Your generosity and commitment to our mission allow the Carlisle Family YMCA to continue making a profound impact on the lives of individuals and families in the Carlisle community.

We've always been dedicated to making sure everyone who wants to be a member of our Y or participate in our programs can do so regardless of their ability to pay. We're grateful for the support of United Way of Carlisle & Cumberland County and other funders, however even with that generosity there's a gap in the funds we receive and the need in our community. We're excited to announce that Brightspeed came on board this year as our **Everyone is Welcome Champion** to help to meet our current need and to expand our reach.

Our membership numbers continued to grow in 2024–25. And one demographic that really got a boost is our youth

and teens 18 & under. If you visited the Basketball Gym after school, you probably noticed that growth. To address the overcrowding in the gym, we introduced the **Afternoon Youth Recreation Initiative**. We opened the Multipurpose Room two afternoons a week for youth ages 12 & under to play basketball and provide other recreation opportunities in a supervised environment.

We expanded our Safety Around Water programming this year. In addition to our 4-day free water safety lessons that include a meal each night, we added **Safety Sundays**. Fourteen families came to get "Water-Ready" before summer. Sessions focused on water safety skills to reduce the risk of drowning and build confidence and competence in and around water. After the lesson, participants practiced the skills and then enjoyed family swim time.

Thank you to everyone who contributed to this **Year of Growth & Momentum**. It's never too late to get involved and be part of the **RIPPLE EFFECT!**

INVESTING IN OUR FUTURE

The Carlisle Family YMCA is excited to expand our impact in our community by purchasing the former Keystone Aquatics Center. This acquisition will allow us to focus our current pool on community programming and the new Aquatic Center on competitive swimming.

EACH TIME OUR Y HAS INVESTED IN OUR FACILITIES, IT HAS RESULTED IN TREMENDOUS GROWTH.

➤➤ After our \$11 million building renovation, we now average 20,000 monthly check-ins, a significant increase over the previous average of 5,000.

➤➤ When we invested in the George B. Stuart Athletic Fields for our CAYS Rec & Travel Soccer programs, participation in both programs multiplied.

We anticipate similar growth in our swim team with the addition of this 50-meter state-of-the-art competition venue.

The acquisition of this new facility is a game-changer for our competitive swim programs. With expanded lane space, deeper water and spectator seating, we can now host larger meets, provide more advanced training opportunities and support our athletes as they reach new levels of performance. Just as important, we'll be able to significantly expand our swim lesson offerings—helping more children and adults in our community gain essential water safety skills and a lifelong love of swimming. **This investment strengthens our mission and deepens our impact across all levels of aquatics.**

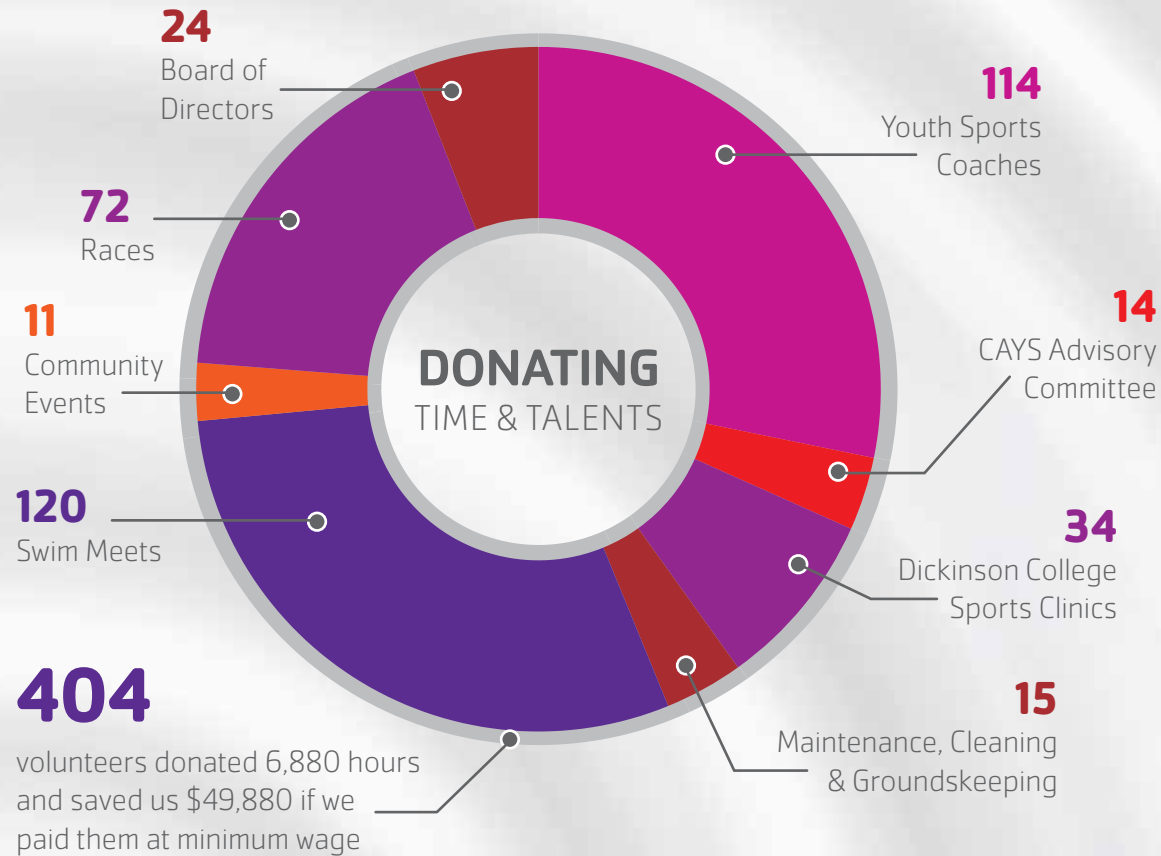
